#### Sweet Summertime

It is certainly true that life seems to speed up in the Spring. Many of us have been moving at a frenetic pace trying to keep up with it all. But now, at last, summer has arrived and I for one look forward to a bit slower pace. Not everything slows down in summer. The grass sure doesn't grow any slower! But some things certainly should slow a bit.

Our liturgical tradition invites us to consider the importance of times and seasons in our Christian living. This is symbolized by the colors you see in church. Festive high energy seasons like Easter and Christmas are decked out in white. More penitential and introspective seasons use purple or blue. But the longest season of all is the season after Pentecost which runs from June though the end of November. Its color is green, which is symbolic I think of the growing season. It takes a long time and lots of patience to grow things. It takes time and patience and space to grow spiritually too!

I think on the whole our society has lost a sense of the importance of rhythm. Too many expect themselves to be "on" all the time. Too many expect others to be "on" all the time. I've noticed many people seem to want every thing to happen instantly as if human life can and should move at the speed of e-mail and cell phone radio signals.

I've begun to wonder, too, if perhaps our children are a bit over-programmed. I remember as a child spending hours doing nothing in particular. A bike, a football, and my friend next door could fill an afternoon. But I suspect that nowadays many kids are conditioned to believe that unless they are achieving something "24-7" then they don't measure up. They're so busy doing they have no time just to be.

Maybe we no longer know how to slow down. Many find it hard to do even while on vacation! How was Disney? "Great, but I'm just exhausted—what a marathon--so glad to be home." I'm reminded of family vacations when we'd load into the car early in the morning and Dad—much more awake than we—would grip the steering wheel and declare with resolve, "We're going to get a good eight hours under our belts today!" And from the backseat there'd be a chorus of groans.

Soon, we'll blink, and the summer will be gone. (Have you noticed the summer is shrinking?!) Until then, slow down. Read something good for your soul. Take some time for quiet and prayer. Listen to the cicadas. Heck, watch the grass grow! And don't forget to get yourself to church on Sunday! If we do this, we might all be amazed just how much we'll grow in our awareness: awareness of ourselves, of others, and most important of all--our awareness of the presence of God.


